SNOW AND INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

YMCA CHILDCARE SCHOOL'S OUT, NO SCHOOL TODAY PROGRAMS - INCLUDES MARLBORO, NEW PALTZ and HIGHLAND SCHOOLS OUT PROGRAMS

The YMCA of Kingston and Ulster County has adopted the following policy in regards to closings and/or class cancellations due to bad weather. In all cases, cancellations, delayed openings, and closings will be announced on the following radio stations: WKNY 1490AM, 331-1490; WDST 100.1FM, 679-7600 X32; WKZE 98.1, 860-346-5800; WBPM 92.9, 471-2300 X1900.

1. **SCHOOL CLOSING:** Always a safe bet to call first (845) 338-3810 or visit us on the web at www.ymcaulster.org. If possible the YMCA will open a program at the Kingston YMCA, NO TRANSPORTATION WILL BE PROVIDED. This program will operate from 8:00am – 6:00pm unless otherwise indicated. **YOU MUST SEND LUNCH AND TWO SNACKS.**
2. **UPLANNED EARLY DISMISSAL:** If Kingston City Schools dismiss early due to weather, or other emergency, there we may offer School's Out program at the **Kingston Branch ONLY. PLEASE CALL AHEAD TO ASSURE THAT PROGRAM IS OFFERED (845) 338-3810. Parents MUST provide transportation to and from the Kingston YMCA.**
3. **2 HOUR DELAY:** In New Paltz, Marlboro, and Highland, our morning School's Out programs also open 2 hours later, and breakfast is not served.

YMCA GROUP FITNESS CLASSES, AQUATIC AND YOUTH PROGRAMS

1. **SCHOOL CLOSING:** All classes, programs and Kids Corner will operate as scheduled unless otherwise indicated. (Always a safe bet to call first (845) 338-3810 or visit us on the web at www.ymcaulster.org).

A decision regarding the cancellation of adult and evening programs and PM Kids Corner will be made as warranted and announced on local radio stations. In all cases, cancellations, delayed openings, and closings will be announced on the following radio stations:
2. **2 HOUR DELAY:** 2 hour delays do not affect aquatic classes or group fitness classes unless class is cancelled by the instructor. **Please call the YMCA for information on these program cancellations.**
3. The YMCA will remain open for member use unless weather conditions are such that it is impossible for the YMCA to remain open. This will be contingent upon sufficient staff being able to get to the YMCA and/or that by requiring staff to remain at the YMCA during a storm poses a safety risk when the staff have to travel home. The decision regarding the closing of the YMCA will be made by the President/CEO. Announcements will be made on local radio stations.
4. Make up dates for scheduled classes cancelled due to inclement weather will be announced at future classes by the instructor.
