## JOB DESCRIPTION

**TITLE:** LEADER IN TRAINING

**REPORTS TO:** CIT / LIT DIRECTOR

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Leader In training must be 14.5 years old as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, and have prior experience in the camp or recreation setting. Candidate must demonstrate maturity, responsibility and people skills. Candidate must be self-motivated and able to work with little direct supervision. LIT must include the four values of Caring, honesty, respect and responsibility in all aspects of Camp Seewackamano life.

## SPECIFIC DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES :

1. Must attend LIT training prior to working with children.
2. Must contract for a minimum of **two sessions**.
3. Assist counselor with group activities.
4. Must be actively involved in activities.
5. Never assume sole responsibility for leading a group.
6. Communicate any concerns, behavioral problems immediately to a counselor or Ad staff. **Never discipline a child.**
7. Be flexible to the changing needs of camp.
8. Assist with projects and tasks as assigned by the CIT/LIT Director
9. Give input which will benefit the camp program
10. Put the needs of the campers first.
11. Serve as a positive role model for children and staff.
12. Display the Character Development values caring, honesty, respect & responsibly.
13. Report any facility needs immediately to staff
14. Submit paperwork in a timely manner

**TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:** LIT's serve a minimum of two sessions, yet can add on more sessions at no additional cost, pending approval be Camp Director. All must attend the pre-camp staff training on **June 18<sup>th</sup>**. Camp dates are **JUNE 25<sup>th</sup> –AUGUST 31<sup>st</sup>**, which include four/two-week sessions and two/one week sessions. Camp is Monday through Friday, 9:00 am-4:00 pm (No camp on July 4<sup>th</sup>.)
